Joni Eareckson Tada has been paralyzed since a diving accident at the age of 17, and as a quadriplegic, is very dependent on the care of others .In "Carried to the Table," she wrote that when she was going through COVID in 2020, the hardest part was having to stay in bed. Ken, her husband, was sicker than she was and unable to care for her completely. And it was difficult to find help during that time of isolation. During the dark nights in bed alone, she found comfort in the power and presence of the Lord with her. God reminded her of His presence and of His powerful promises. She found comfort in the Word of God through specific Scriptures that the Lord brought to mind, and Joni held on to those wonderful truths for life and literal breath during that difficult time. She magnified the Lord as the one who loved her, cared for her, and continued to have a plan and purpose for her life. She was able to rediscover the bigness of God in that trying situation.

We are excited about Vacation Bible School and our theme for VBS -> MAGNIFIED. We will be discovering the bigness of God in the smallest of things. Through song and worship, Bible study and missions, crafts and recreation, and a host of other fun activities, we will learn that we have a lot of reasons to magnify the Lord and proclaim His greatness. 

Children in our Preschool Dept. will have an I Love Tuesday just for them! We are going to Humpty Jumpty in Columbia, MS. Each preschooler will need a chaperone (parent/grandparent/guardian/babysitter). Older siblings are invited to join in the fun. We will leave FBC at 9 am and return by 1:30 pm. Cost is \$20 per child and they must wear socks. The only cost for adults is lunch (about \$10, menu available online but must be preordered when you sign up.).
