LADIES DAY - BLOSSOM CHURCH OF CHRIST

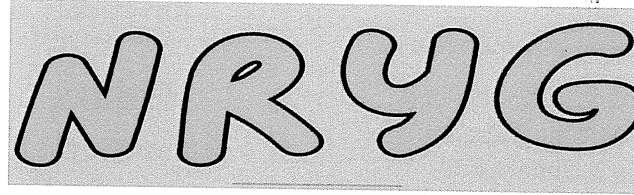

Mary Taylor - Is still having health problems, and has upcoming hemoglobin tests to be scheduled.

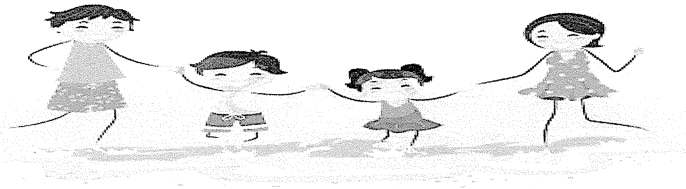
Karen Reed - Is undergoing cancer treatments but feeling better.
