# SERMON "QUESTIONS FROM MARK: WHO IS THE GREATEST?" Sr. Pastor Jason Scheler

They went on from there and passed through Galilee. And he did not want anyone to know, <sup>31</sup> for he was teaching his disciples, saying to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill him. And when he is killed, after three days he will rise."

<sup>32</sup>But they did not understand the savina, and were afraid to ask him.

<sup>33</sup>And they came to Capernaum. And when he was in the house he asked them, "What were you discussing on the way?" <sup>34</sup>But they kept silent, for on the way they had argued with one another about who was the greatest.

<sup>35</sup>And he sat down and called the twelve. And he said to them, "If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all."

<sup>36</sup>And he took a child and put him in the midst of them, and taking him in his arms, he said to them, <sup>37</sup>"Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me, and whoever receives me, receives not me but him who sent me." (Mark 9:30-37)

(v30-31)

For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

2. WHY DID THEY \_\_\_\_\_ UNDERSTAND AND WERE AFRAID? (v32) And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, "Far be it from you, Lord! This shall never happen to you." (Matthew 16:22)

3.	NOTIONS
	THAT THEY CAN'T UNDERSTAND SIMPLE SPIRITUAL
	(v33-34) So the Jews said to him, "What sign do you show us for doing these things?" <sup>19</sup> Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." <sup>20</sup> The Jews then said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?" <sup>21</sup> But he was speaking about the temple of his body. <sup>22</sup> When therefore he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the Scripture and the word that Jesus had spoken. (John 2:18-22)
4.	GREATNESS IN GOD'S KINGDOM IS BEING TO ALL. (v35)  Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. *Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. (Philippians 2:3-4)
5.	GOD WANTS TO RECONCILE OTHERS THROUGH (v37) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. <sup>18</sup> All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; <sup>19</sup> that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. (2 Corinthians 5:17-20)
