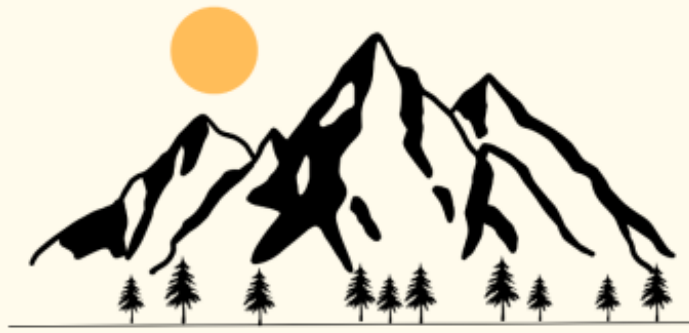

WHEN WE PRAY...GOD'S POWER IS ON DISPLAY

Ephesians 3:14-15

¹⁴ For this reason I kneel before the Father,

¹⁵ from whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name. ¹⁶ I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,

Real power is not about external control, but internal transformation.

The priority of our prayer shouldn't necessarily be about asking God to change our circumstances as much as it should be asking God to change us.

This is not surface level faith. This is Spirit-filled living.
