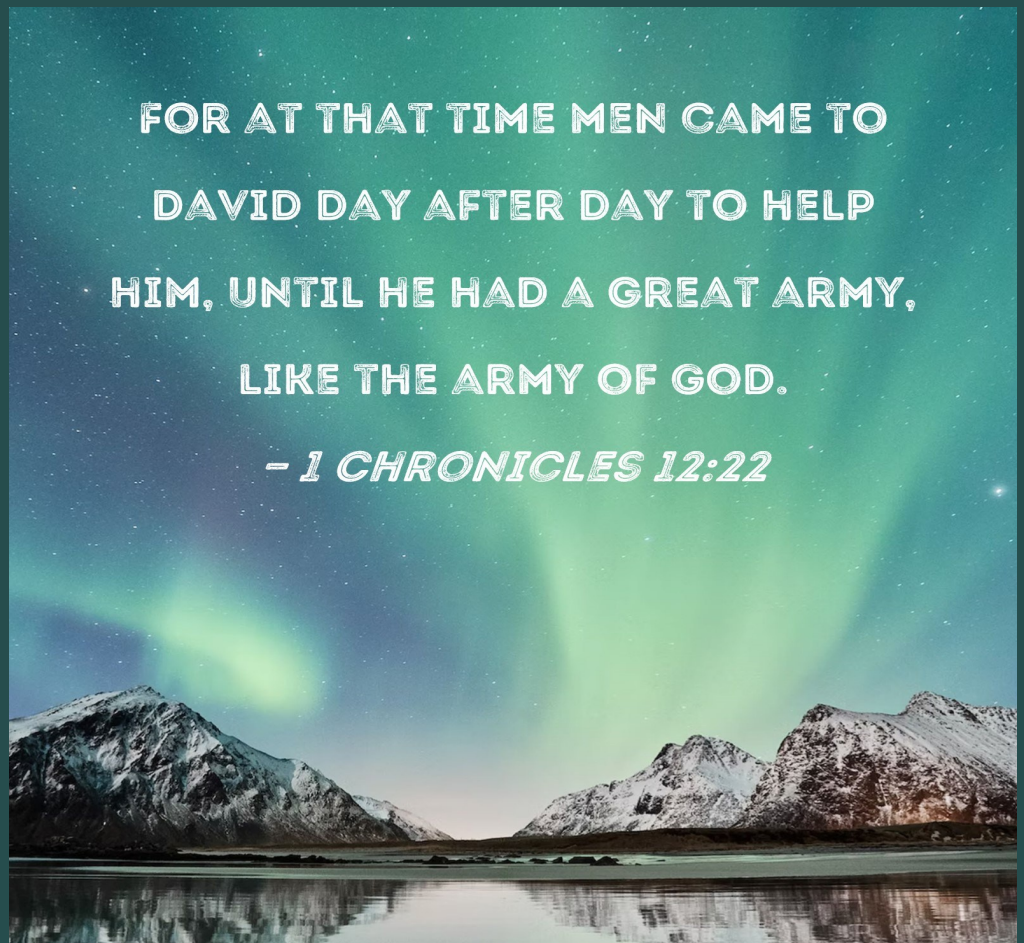

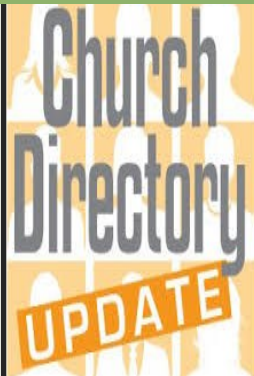

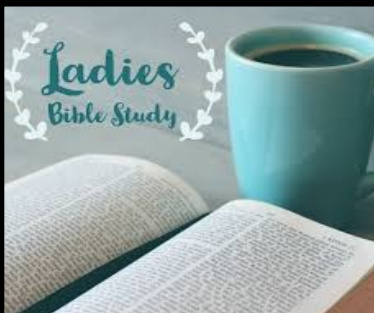

Weaver's Writings:

The Scriptures Guide Us Through Depression and Anxiety

In times of deep sadness, fear, or worry, many of us struggle to see a way forward. Depression and anxiety can feel like overwhelming storms, clouding our hearts and minds. But even in the darkest valleys, God has not left us without comfort. His Word is a lamp to our feet and a light to our path (Psalm 119:105). The Scriptures do not ignore our struggles; they speak directly to them.

God Understands Our Pain

The Bible shows us that even faithful men and women wrestled with deep sorrow. David cried out, "I am weary with my moaning; every night I flood my bed with tears" (Psalm 6:6). Elijah once prayed, "It is enough; now, O Lord, take away my life" (1 Kings 19:4). Jesus Himself, in the garden of Gethsemane, said, "My soul is very sorrowful, even to death" (Matthew 26:38). The presence of depression or anxiety does not mean we have failed as Christians. It means we are human, and we desperately need God's comfort and strength.

God is Close to the Brokenhearted

Psalm 34:18 declares, "The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit." This is not a distant God who watches without care, but a Father who draws near to us when we feel crushed. Isaiah 41:10 reminds us, "Fear not, for I am with you... I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand." These are not empty promises, they are spoken by the One who cannot lie (Titus 1:2).

We Are Called to Cast Our Cares on Him

In our seasons of anxiety, the apostle Peter offers us a lifeline: "Casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7). This isn't just about reciting words in prayer, it is an invitation to hand our burdens to a God who truly cares. Paul also encourages, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God" (Philippians 4:6). These verses don't promise instant relief, but they remind us where to turn when anxiety tightens its grip.

God Provides Peace Beyond Understanding

Paul follows his exhortation in Philippians 4 with this promise: "And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:7). Peace may not mean the absence of struggle, but it does mean a steady calm that holds us fast, even when everything else feels unsteady.

We Are Not Alone

The church is a family, a body designed to support and care for one another. Galatians 6:2 instructs, "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ." If you are struggling, you are not weak and you are not alone. We are here to help each other walk through hard seasons, always looking to Jesus, "a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief" (Isaiah 53:3).

If you are dealing with depression or anxiety, know that you are not forgotten by God. He sees you. He loves you. His Word is full of truth, hope, and healing. And your church family is here to walk with you in love.
