Living for What Lasts

In John 10:10, Jesus reminds us that He came so that we might have life, and have it more abundantly. But what does "abundant life" truly mean? It's not about the temporary things of this world – possessions, status, or fleeting pleasures. These will all pass away. Instead, abundant life is rooted in the eternal blessings that come from God.

That's why our focus must be on seeking the Kingdom of God and His righteousness (*Matthew 6:33*). We must recognize the signs of the times the Bible speaks of and prepare our hearts, not only to be used by God but to enter into His Kingdom. Heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word and promises remain forever (*Matthew 24:35*).

Living for the Kingdom also means understanding how to conduct ourselves in God's house. When we come to church, we should come with a heart ready to worship – not weighed down by distractions, complaints, or worldly burdens. In God's presence, we have the opportunity to lay those burdens down and receive His peace.

Every time we gather, we are coming into contact with the <u>living</u> God. We should enter with reverence, expectation, and a readiness to worship in spirit and truth. If we approach Him with a pure heart and sincere praise, God will meet us right where we are.

Let's prepare ourselves daily – not only to live in His presence now, but to be ready for the day we enter His **eternal** Kingdom.
