One thing I can tell you for sure is that even though he hasn't started his first official day, Jon is already plugged in and hard at work for TBC.

Jon Reed earned a Master of Divinity degree from Southern Seminary, and before that, he earned a Bachelor of Science in English with a minor in Journalism from East Tennessee State University. He has 30 years of experience as a senior pastor, 18 of those at his current church. He also served as the Youth Pastor and as a Team Pastor for Averett University's football team in Danville, VA.

He and his wife, Leann have 3 boys, Austin, Isaac, and Lane. Jon's first week will begin on August 25th, and he plans to begin preaching on Sunday, August 31. I think one of Jon's strong points is how involved he is in the community. Where the people are, that's where you will find him.

Jon has already been serving TBC and the community in ways some of you may have seen and maybe some ways you haven't. Immediately after being affirmed, he reached out to some people at TBC about feeding students at Tusculum University outside of the SPOT ministry.

Monday, August 4, there was a SPOT meeting. Jon mentioned attending that as well and will be speaking at the first SPOT meeting. I can't leave out Leann either. From what I gather, she plans to attend the Summer Garden Tea Party on Saturday, August 23rd. All of this, before they officially start.

Jon has been asking questions about Wednesday night Bible study and is already working on a series for it. Keep your eye on the bulletin for details on that. It's clear that Jon is ready to hit the ground running; the question now is, are we? I am excited to see what God has in store for TBC and the new ways we can minister to our community.
