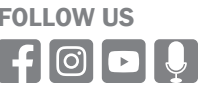

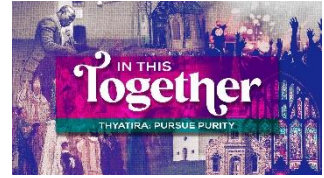

How can humility, the pursuit of purity, and confession and repentance of sin, testify and witness to the grace, mercy, compassion, and power of God? When these qualities are present in our Christian communities (humility, righteousness, confession, repentance) what are we proclaiming about Jesus to our not-yet-believing friends and neighbors? 4. How does Jesus encourage his faithful followers in Thyatira? What are they to continue to let go of, and who/what are they to continue to cling to? (24-25) 5.
