In what ways can the Church, when facing persecution and suffering, be encouraged and motivated to continue by the example and words of Jesus?</li> <li>4. Give testimony or journal about how suffering and persecution in your own life has produced a greater dependence on God, and a deeper sense of belonging to your local Christian community.</li> <li>5.
