



WHEN WE PRAY... OUR FEARS MELT AWAY

Acts 4:8,12a,19-20, 23-26,29, 31

- <sup>8</sup> Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them:
- <sup>12</sup> "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved."
- <sup>19</sup> ... "Judge for yourselves whether it is right in God's sight to obey you rather than God. <sup>20</sup> For we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard."
- <sup>23</sup> On their release, Peter and John went back to their own people and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said to them.
- <sup>24</sup> When they heard this, they raised their voices together in prayer to God. "Sovereign Lord," they said, "you made the heaven and the earth and the sea, and everything in them. <sup>25</sup> You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of your servant, our father David: "Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? <sup>26</sup> The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the Lord and against his Anointed One."
- <sup>29</sup> Now, Lord, consider their threats and <u>enable your servants to speak your word with great</u> boldness.
- <sup>31</sup> After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
