- 2. From verses 1-3, summarize the role of the Levitical High Priests in Judaism.
- 3. From verse 2, how was the humanity of the high priests as asset as they helped sinners come to God?
- 4. According to verse 3, because of the sin nature of the high priests, what was required that they do?
- 5. According to verses 5:5-6 and 10, who appointed Jesus Christ as high priest?
- 6. How does verse 7 characterize the ministry of Jesus for His people?
- 7. From verses 7-10, how was Jesus' active obedience essential in order for Him to bring men to God?
- 8. In your own words, summarize how these verses show that Jesus is better than the Levitical system and its human priests.

9. *For deeper study*: To what theological truth is the author referring when he writes that Christ "learned obedience" and that He was made "perfect?" How do Luke 2:40 and Romans 5:18-21 help you understand the necessity of Christ's active obedience?
