### Psalm 145:18

1 John 5:14

Throughout Scripture, God provided for His people in miraculous ways:

### Moses and the Israelites:

When the Israelites were thirsty in the desert, God provided water from a rock.

 Psalm 78:15

# **Hagar in the Desert:**

When Hagar and her son were desperate, God opened her eyes to a well of water.

• "Then God opened her eyes and she saw a well of water. So she went and filled the skin with water and gave the boy a drink."

Genesis 21:19
