What's Blooming at Christ Church? August 13th, 2025



Spiraea japonica 'Lemon Princess', commonly known as Lemon Princess Spirea, is a compact, mounding shrub growing in the labyrinth. With the recent heat wave the specimens here have finished blooming. Although it produces delicate pink flowers in clusters in late spring, it is grown for its vibrant chartreuse-yellow foliage. The leaves maintain their colour throughout the

growing season, which makes it a good choice for its inclusion in the planting at Christ Church. Lemon Princess Spiraea typically grows 2-3 feet tall and wide. The name "Spiraea" refers to a genus of about 80 to 100 species of shrubs in the family Rosaceae (The Rose Family.)

This low-maintenance shrub is known for its adaptability, heat tolerance, and deer resistance. It thrives in full sun or partial shade and is adaptable to most soil conditions. This shrub is relatively low-maintenance. It can be pruned to maintain a desired shape and to encourage new growth after flowering. Shearing off the blooms after flowering or pruning the shrub to reduce by about 1/3 can also encourage a second set of bloom later in the summer. This shrub is excellent for borders, foundation plantings, or as a low hedge.
