


Nearly everyone has been to a "Job Fair" or "Trade Show" where

These short Books provide insight into God's character and His desire for relationship with His people. They contain important messages for both the people then and believers today — messages of justice and mercy for sin and rebellion, along with messages of hope and God's faithfulness to those who seek Him.
