







CANAAN - PART 12

Genesis 19:30-38

Faith vs Fear Decision Making

1. Fear "sees" only <u>limitations</u>, <u>inadequacies</u> and <u>danger</u>, but faith "sees" <u>opportunities</u> to "see" God at work.

Now Lot went up out of Zoar and lived in the hills with his two daughters, for he was afraid to live in Zoar. - Genesis 19:30a

2. Fear can lead to isolation, but faith can lead to deeper relationships with God and others.

So he lived in a cave with his two daughters. - Genesis 19:30b

3. Fear can lead to poor <u>choices</u>, bad <u>consequences</u> and deep <u>regrets</u>; but faith can lead to a life of <u>freedom</u>.

For we walk by faith, not by sight. - 2 Corinthians 5:7
