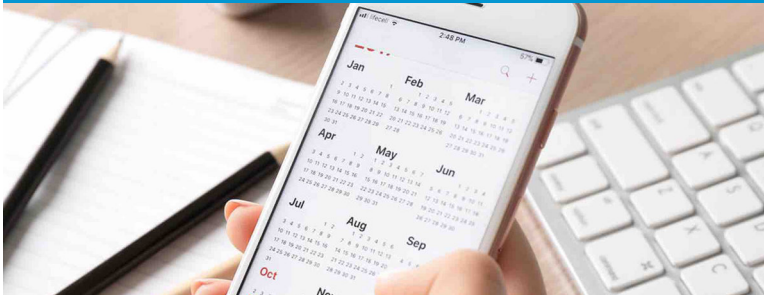

2025 in Anchorage,
Alaska with SEND
International



Anchorage in Alaska is a central hub for missionaries who serve in remote villages in the northern part of the USA. Those who serve, come and go for a variety of reasons. Missionary work in Alaska includes church planting, discipleship, youth outreach and community development. A significant portion of work takes place in remote villages, often accessible only by small plane or boat. They share their faith, provide various forms of support, build trust and establish strong relationships with individuals and leaders in the Alaskan North.

SEND International has a variety of ministries in the North and one of these is a four apartment guest house. Just last year, 755 nights were booked for missionaries to stay either for an overnight or a short term stay due to emergencies. One incident from a family who serves in Alaska share this story:

"It became clear that we needed to get to a doctor in Anchorage immediately. Something was not right with my family member's heart. We were thankful that we were one flight away from a hospital. While we attended to this urgent health need, we were able to stay at the SEND guest house right near the airport. Without this facility, we wouldn't have had a place to call home when we really needed the medical care."

When we saw an opportunity to serve at this guest house, we were excited. It is like taking care of a motel which somehow was on our minds during the past year. It will also be a great chance to step into the mission field through Send International Organization. Although this does not involve or focus on Biblical teaching, preaching or sharing the Gospel to a particular group of people, we are indirectly serving a community that shares the Gospel. It is also a great place to get to know the different missionaries who serve the minority groups in Alaska. This guest house is a hub where they can get some medical checkups, have a short term stay before heading back to their hometown. By

Benny and I committing to go serve at the guest house, we are providing coverage for the couple who are full time hosts at the apartment, to take a few weeks off to travel to the southern USA.

Christine and I will make sure that their rooms are ready and tidy with the essentials stocked for a comfortable stay. We are looking forward to listening to different kinds of testimonies which in return will strengthen our little faith in order to move forward and serve more in the future. May God reveal His plan for us through this mission trip.

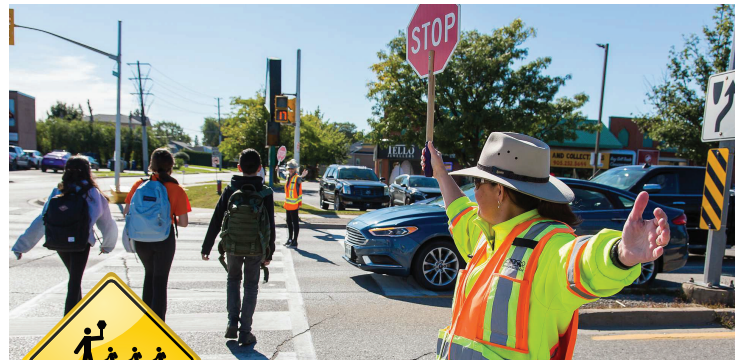

Highway 50 & Patterson Sideroad

Relief crossing guards do not have regular crossing guard shifts every day; they provide coverage when a regular guard is unavailable.

- Rate of pay is \$24.38 per hour.
- Shifts are 8:40 - 9:10 a.m. & 3:30 - 4:00 p.m.
- Guards work approximately 30 minutes and get paid for 1 hour.
- We supply the vests, raincoats and stop signs.
