If you write a check, please make it out to Prince of Peace Lutheran Church with 'Gross Fundraiser' on the memo line. You can also give online by visiting our website, clicking the 'Give' tab, and selecting 'Gross Fundraiser' from the dropdown menu.

All money raised during the Gross Fundraiser goes to the youth program, specifically three areas: covering costs for our largest Youth Group outreach in December called 'Shop and Wrap'; supporting Living Water Ministries where our youth can attend camp; and saving for the National Youth Gathering 2027 — registration and deposits for our trip will begin next spring!
