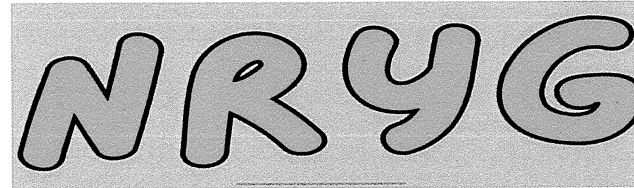


Dear North Ridge Family,
