#### DROP OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURES

## **Morning Drop-off**

<u>Students may only be dropped off at the main school entrance (Stadium Blvd) in the morning</u>. The main school entrance will be the only point of entry during morning dropoff. Drivers should enter off of Swifts Hwy. and follow the drive around the church to the front of the school. Cars should form a continuous, single file line.

If parents need to come into the building or there is another delay, please park in the parking lot.

#### Before School Drop-off Procedure

- Drop-off at main school entrance
- · See the diagram for traffic flow
- If you need to park turn left before entering the drop-off lane and park on the 2nd or 3rd level of the parking lot.
- Please do not get out of your car in the drop-off lane.
- NO LEFT TURN onto Stadium Blvd. Please turn right to exit the parking lot and keep traffic flowing.

#### **After School Dismissal**


During after school dismissal students in grades PK-4 without older siblings exit the building from the back door of the school. Drivers picking up students in grades PK-4 should enter the lower church parking lot off of Swifts Hwy and form a double line around the outside lane of the parking lot. Please see the attached map showing the flow of traffic.

Grades 5-8 and younger siblings are picked up from the front of the school. Follow cones and teacher direction (see arrows on map) for directions on car lines.

#### After School Dismissal Procedure

- Please do not arrive for pick-up prior to 2:45 P M
- Please have your child's last name visible on the dashboard of your vehicle.
- See the diagram to know how to line up in the car line.
- Please do not park your vehicle in any part of the parking lot.
- If you need to go into the school office, please follow exit procedures first and return through the Jefferson/Stadium Street roundabout to park after pick up procedures at 3:25...
