

What is the Gospel?

What is the most important message in the world? Is it a political platform, a new scientific discovery, or a philosophy for living? While these may have their place, none can compare to the good news that God has given to us. This good news is what the Bible calls the "gospel." The word itself simply means "good news" or "glad tidings." But what, specifically, is this good news?

The apostle Paul gives a concise and powerful summary of the gospel in 1 Corinthians 15:3-4: "For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures."

In breaking down this foundational truth, we see three important components. The first being that Christ died for our sins. This addresses the most fundamental problem facing every human being: our sin. Romans 3:23 tells us, "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Sin separates us from our holy God, and the penalty for that sin is death (Romans 6:23). But God, in His immense love, did not leave us without a solution. He sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to be the perfect sacrifice. Jesus, who lived a sinless life, took our place on the cross. His death was not an accident; it was a purposeful act to pay the debt we could not pay. He died "for our sins."

Paul goes on to state that Jesus was buried. This simple statement confirms the reality of His death. Jesus was truly and physically dead. His burial shows that His life on earth had ended, and the price had been fully paid. There was no question of His death, it was an established fact witnessed by many.

Finally, Jesus was raised on the third day. 3. This is the glorious culmination of the gospel. If Jesus had only died and been buried, He would be no different from any other prophet or teacher. But the tomb could not hold Him! His resurrection proves that He is who He claimed to be: the Son of God, the Messiah, and the conqueror of death. His resurrection is the ultimate sign of God's power and the proof that His sacrifice was accepted. Because He lives, we can have hope. Hope for forgiveness, hope for a new life, and hope for our own resurrection one day (1 Corinthians 15:20-22).

Why does this matter for us? In a world of bad news, the gospel is still the best news. It changes lives, restores hope, and gives us a reason to live faithfully (Titus 2:11–14). The message hasn't changed and neither has its power. Have you obeyed the gospel? The same invitation Jesus gave in the first century is open today: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:28)
