The fall Shenandoah River **District Lay Servant Academy** is scheduled for Saturday, September 13th at Macedonia United Methodist Church, 1941 Macedonia Church Road, Stephens City.

Our classes will be the Basic course, taught by Rev. Stephen Creech, pastor at Manor Memorial UMC; United Methodist Heritage, taught by Rev. Larry Davies, a retired elder and former district superintendent in the Virginia Conference; Leading Bible Studies, taught by Rev. Joel Robinette, pastor at Keezeletown UMC, and Leading Worship, led by Rev. Susan Catlett, pastor at Emmanuel UMC.

We will gather shortly after 8:00 a.m. in the upstairs lobby of the Macedonia UMC sanctuary. The folks at Macedonia will offer a breakfast and coffee. The day will begin at 9:00 a.m., with a worship service featuring newly appointed District Superintendent Rev. Kyungsuk Cho.

Online registration will begin around August. 5. The registration fee will be \$20. Lunch will be provided with a free will offering. Classes will end around 4 p.m. We also are pursuing the possibility of offering shared transportation to Macedonia UMC. More details should be available shortly.

In addition to the district training opportunities, you can find other places to pursue Lay Servant classes. The Virginia Conference is conducting a virtual Lay Servant Academy on August. 15-16. Classes include the Basic Course, a class in Spiritual Gifts, and a class in United Methodist Polity. Details and registration are available here:
