Text: **Romans 5:1-11**

Key Ideas from the Sermon:

- The results of our being restored back into right relationship with God through faith (Justification) through the death and resurrection of Jesus, is:
- Peace with God, a relationship of grace with God, hope despite our sufferings and ultimately reconciliation with God.
- God's amazing love for us is demonstrated in the fact that Jesus became our substitute on the cross, paying the penalty of our sin, so that we could be forgiven and reconciled to God – and he did this while we were sinners; while we were enemies of God.
- This is the amazing grace and love of God for us.

Bible Study: The Swedish Method [Rom 5:1-11]

1. Begin by praying, asking God to speak through His Word
2. Read the Bible passage aloud, being careful to read slowly
3. Go back over the passage (allow about 10 minutes of silence), being on the lookout for, and making notes on the following four things:



Light bulb: This should be something that 'shine' from the passage - whatever impacts most, or draws attention.

Question mark: Anything that is difficult to understand in the text, or a question the reader might like to ask the writer of the passage, or the Lord.
