Exodus 24-31

How Do We Enter God's Presence? Aug 17, 2025

## For Younger Kids:

- 1. What's the difference between a playground and a library? One is for fun, the other is special. God's presence is even more special!
- 2. Why do you think God gave the Israelites a special tent (the tabernacle) to meet with Him? What's a special place where you feel close to God?
- 3. Jesus made it possible for us to be close to God anytime. How do you like to talk to God—through prayer, singing, or drawing?

### For Older Kids & Preteens:

- 1. Righteousness is about living rightly with people; holiness is about drawing close to God. Why do we need both in our lives?
- 2. The Israelites had to be careful about how they approached God.

What does it mean to take God seriously and not casually?

3. The covenant with Israel was sealed with blood, pointing forward to Jesus.

How does Jesus make it possible for us to be near God without fear?

### For Teens & Adults:

- 1. Holiness is about sacred space and God's presence; righteousness is about actions in daily life. Why do Christians sometimes focus on one more than the other?
- 2. The tabernacle was a way to train Israel's imagination about God's holiness.

What helps shape your imagination today about who God is?

God set the terms for approaching Him—Israel couldn't make their own rules.

What are some ways people today try to approach God on their own terms?

4. Jesus is our high priest who gave us permanent access to God's presence.

How should that truth shape our worship, prayer, and daily confidence?

# Family Challenge:

As a family, create two short lists:

- Ways we can live righteously (kindness, honesty, generosity).
- Ways we can honor God's holiness (worship, prayer, reverence).

Then pray together, thanking Jesus for giving you access to God's presence and asking Him to help you live both holyand righteous lives.
