

Job Description Youth/Young Adults Pastor

Vision Statement

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Responsible for the spiritual development of HMC youth/young adult ministry participants. Ensuring discipleship opportunities for our youth and young adults.

PRIMARY FUNCTION:

Coordinate time with teens and young adults for worship, discipleship, fellowship, volunteer, and community outreach opportunities.

GENERAL FUNCTION:

The Youth/Young Adults Pastor must be able to perform various duties and responsibilities, thus fulfilling the church's calling to minister to youth and young adults. This should be accomplished by being a Christ-centered leader and Christ-loving follower. The following are some of the duties and responsibilities a Ministry Assistant should be able to execute:

PRINCIPLE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Administration and implementation of numerous youth/young adult programs such as evangelism, retreats, Bible Study sessions, and worship services.
- Recruit, train, and lead volunteers for the efficient implementation of church ministries.
- Incorporate various principles of spiritual development used to help people grow spiritually.
- To be used by God as a vessel of personal spiritual growth and renewal in the lives of the youth and young adults.
- Provide guidance to youth and young adults, helping them realize their unique God-driven goals.
- Engage and build relationships with parents of youth to support their children's involvement and participation in the church.
- Researches and selects age-appropriate curriculum.
- Participate and contribute to church meetings.
- Connect with local middle and high schools as well as local colleges.

• Ensures fiscal responsibility and adheres to departmental budgets.

JOB SKILL SET:

- Active and growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ, evidenced by action, attitude, and behavior.
- A passion for youth and young adult ministry.
- Effective communication skills (written, verbal, and interpersonal).
- Demonstrated ability to understand and relate to the youth and young adults.
- Competency with basic computer software (Excel, Word, Publisher).
- Ability to share faith, testimony, and scripture with others to evangelize as well as train others to do so.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must follow Biblical directives concerning Christian conduct and holy living.
- Must attend Lord's Supper and Baptism services
- Ability to lead either a Youth or Young Adult Sunday School class.
- Must maintain regular private devotion

- Weekly Check-in with Senior Pastor at first, then monthly.
- Practice spiritual disciplines (such as meditating on Scripture, prayer, journaling, fasting, witnessing, rest, silence, solitude, etc.) as a means of setting the leader's heart affection on Christ
- Fully support and engage in the spiritual formation vision of Hopewell Methodist Church.
