# Reflection

### **Maturity**

Mary Healy helps us understand the significance of the Letter to the Hebrews, chapter 12:

Three images help us to see the Christian life in true perspective.

First, our life is an endurance race in which we are striving toward the finish line, cheered on by those who have gone before us.

Second, our life is growth toward maturity through the discipline of a loving Father.

Third, our life is a joyous liturgical assembly on a holy mountain amidst angels and saints (Hebrews, p. 257).

Our focus is maturity; next week, the communion of saints.

It is parents who raise children, and this requires love. Real love requires two words:

#### Yes and No.

We must be able to say yes to good things, known as virtue. We must be able to say no to bad things, known as vice.

So, naturally and supernaturally enough, God does the same thing with us on our journey from and to him:

My son, when the Lord corrects you, do not treat it lightly, and do not get discouraged when he reprimands you (Hebrews 12).

The word for 'correct' can mean 'training' or 'education.'

We let God have his way with us.

Amen.


