*Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice. Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. Philippians 4: 4-5*

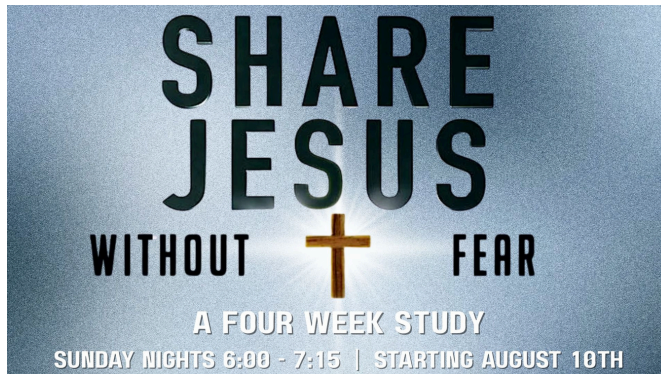

### Member Testimony- Reagan Robinson

This pushed her to grow closer to the Lord and get into His word. Reagan said, "If we focus on god's truth and what he says about us, that affects us so strongly". After this year of struggle, Reagan knew she needed community, but she wanted to ensure that it was the right kind of community. So for her last two years of high school, she attended CHESS Christian School. There, she met Davey.
