In the case of the church in Corinth, Paul laid the foundation and then _____ built on what Paul had begun.

The foundation of Christianity is laid. We are building on that foundation now.

Primarily this passage is referring to those people who preach and teach Christ, but it also includes every believer.

What is this foundation that Paul has laid? It can only be Christ and His whole Word.

The whole New Testament is Christ: Christ-His life on Earth in the Gospels; Christ active in the church-the book of Acts; Christ’s work commented on and explained-the Epistles; Christ coming again-the Revelation.

If the foundation _____, everything _____.

You may try to set Jesus aside. He’s the only foundation on which a life can be built, on which a faith can be built, on which a nation can be built, a home, anything.

All right, let’s go to the third point. We’ve spoken of the master builder, then the foundation is laid, and on top of that foundation comes number three, the _____.

This is an admission that all churches won’t end up being the same, any more than all Christians will. The Spirit of God knew

that there would be varying kinds of Christians and varying kinds of churches.
