

This is a resource for small groups aimed at growing and establishing Christians as lifelong disciple of Jesus.

There are 4 units to this resource.

- 1) Following Jesus
- 2) Growing from God's Word
- 3) Loving God's People
- 4) Living the Gospel


For the remainder of 2025, Small Groups will have access to Unit One, a discipleship resource with 5 video-based studies designed to run over 10 sessions.
