**Dress Code for Liturgical Ministers at the Altar- EM's, Lectors, Adult and Youth Altar Servers**  
*Your attire should demonstrate your appreciation of how your role fits within the worship experience. Dress should express respect and reverence for the sacred mysteries that are being celebrated.*

Women

- Professional/modest attire
- Dress pants, no jeans or shorts
- No halter or tube tops
- No sleeveless, low-cut or spaghetti straps

Men

- Collared shirt, jacket or sweater
- Dress pants, no jeans or shorts
- Closed shoes and socks, no athletic shoes or sandals

ALL

- Please no athletic shoes, flip flops, etc.
- No jeans, shorts or sweat pants
- No sweatshirts, t-shirts, tank-tops, athletic attire or graphic wear

**Lectors**- Lector 1 does the first reading and Lector 2 does the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading.

**Please let the deacon know 10 minutes before your scheduled Mass that you are present.**

**Extraordinary Ministers**- Please make sure that you know which station you are assigned. If you got a substitute for the day, please let him/her know the designated station.

If you notice an extra priest or deacon in the sanctuary wearing an alb or stole at communion time, please someone refrain from coming forward. The priest or deacon is there to distribute Holy Communion. It is the role of the ordained clergy to distribute the Eucharist. The service of an extraordinary minister is critical if there are not enough clergy present.

**Please let the deacon know 10 minutes before Mass that you are present.**

**Altar Servers**- Servers should be vested and in the sacristy **15 minutes** prior to Mass time to assist with any last minute preparations. Please make sure all items are removed from the sanctuary at the conclusion of Mass. Please hang all albs and cinctures neatly in the designated area at the end of Mass.
