What is Legacy?

Legacy = a. an amount of money or property **left to someone** in a will. b. the long-lasting impact **left to someone** of particular events, actions, etc. that took place in the past, in a person's life.

Jesus' intention was to leave a **living legacy**
that echoes throughout eternity, and
reverberates around the entire planet until He
returns.

“All authority in heaven and on earth has
been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of
all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father
and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,”

Then they came to Jerusalem. 1. Trust It – then live it

2. Transform It -show it the world

and when necessary use words.

Our purpose is to be **Salt** and **Light**!

You are the salt of the earth. But if the **salt** loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot. You are the **light** of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, **let your light shine before others**, that they may **see your good deeds** and glorify your Father in heaven.

Salt – purifying effect, preservation,
seasoning

Light – joy, illumination in a dark world,
inspirational, presence of God (Menorah)

4. Transfer It – then cover them in prayer
