

"Amillennialists believe the spiritual realities of the millennium are already present." 1 - God's kingdom has come, and God's will is being done.

"The events of history are unfolding like a cornucopia of grace, with the spiritual realities of Christ's kingdom progressing and expanding according to God's mission for gathering and blessing his people."

3 - The New Testament shows us how to interpret the Old Testament prophecies.

"Amillennialists claim that we should view Old Testament prophecies as the Holy Spirit has directed through the lens of the New Testament."

The contrast between the Old Testament and the New Testament is between shadow and reality, promise and fulfillment.

"This perspective understands the New Testament to be teaching us how we should interpret the Old Testament prophecies in the way that it shows us how Christ fulfilled the symbols and types that prefigured him."

"The shadows are not to be restored in the future because they have been entirely fulfilled in Christ."

4 - God has had one unified plan for the entirety of both testaments.
