 - A. Use in human relationships (singular)

B. Used for God (plurality)

- III. The Name Reveals Ownership
 - A. The closeness of a committed servant- Gen. 18:16

B. Help - Ex. 4:10

C. Care - 2 Sam. 7:18-21; John 13:13-14

D. Encouragement- Josh. 7:7; Jud. 6:13-16; Dan. 9:3-19

E. Spiritual provision

- How can this name encourage us not to hesitate in obedience? What areas are we tempted to hesitate in obeying the Master's commands?
- What are some visible actions you have carried out last week that resulted in people praising the Lord and His goodness?

- As a disciple of our Lord Jesus Christ, are you being obedient to the service of the Good Master?
