Student Aid for Post-secondary Students

General Fund income was low in July, even for a summer month, being almost \$7,300 under budget. Expenses were also under budget, but by a lesser amount. Our deficit of \$3,132.26 reduces the General Fund balance to a little under \$90,000, which reduces our grade from A+ to A.

The review engagement of our previous fiscal year will be completed soon, and a written report given to church members before our membership meeting in September. I'll remind you that gifts to our Student Aid Fund are helpful at this time of year. Thank you for giving to the Lord's work at PTC!
