

"I Speak Jesus" Songs of Summer Series

- 1. The sermon compared seeing God in the mountains versus the prairies. In your own life, what "surroundings" (busyness, hardship, joy, routine) make it harder—or easier—for you to see God clearly?
- 2. Names carry meaning. Have you ever reflected on the meaning of your own name? How does the meaning of Jesus' name—"Yahweh saves"—shape the way you approach Him in prayer or worship?
- 3. The angel told Joseph to name the child Jesus because He would "save His people from their sins" (Matt. 1:21). How does remembering this truth change how you face doubts, fears, or unanswered prayers?
- 4. The sermon emphasized peace as one of the starkest contrasts between believers and unbelievers. When have you experienced God's peace in a way that didn't make sense given your circumstances?
- 5. Romans 15:13 says God fills us with *joy and peace as we trust Him, so that we overflow with hope*. Where in your life are you currently struggling to trust Him, and how might hope grow there if you did?
- 6. The song "I Speak Jesus" highlights that His name brings healing, freedom, and life. Where do you personally need to "speak Jesus" over your life right now? (ex: family, health, fears, relationships, future)
- 7. At the end of the sermon, the challenge was to write Jesus' name over the things you struggle to trust Him with. If you were to do that right now, what would you write His name over? How can the group support you in that step of faith?
