Please Don't Forget!

- **Adult Verification Forms for all men and women 18 years and older**
 - To ensure safety for all on the campgrounds, **EVERY** adult over 18 that is on the grounds will need to have their pastor complete a signed Adult Verification form or you will not be able to enter the grounds.
- **Medical Authorization Forms for all girls under 18 years**
 - You will need **two copies** of the Medical Authorization form for every girl and teenager that is attending camp with you. **One copy will be turned in at check-in.** You will keep the other copy with you.
