4. Being with God

According to Dallas Willard, God wants us to pray because it is:

- 1. **Relational:** prayer draws us close as children to our Father (Matt. 6:6).
- 2. **Formational:** prayer transforms our desires & gives us peace (Phil. 4:6–7).
- 3. **Participatory:** prayer lets us share in God's Kingdom work (Matt. 6:9–10; James 5:16–18).
- 4. **Fruitful:** prayer flows out of abiding in Christ, shaping us to will and to act with Him (John 15:7).

And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate* the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.





Pray Php 4:6-7 Surrender, be with him.

How it forms you (vision)

It allows us to live a life of guidance and protection even with the necessary discipline

Heart change (intention)


To live in complete union with God with a humble, trusting, and surrendered heart
