Our mission is to reach out and actively engage others by sharing our Christian faith, worshiping, studying the Bible, praying, and serving God in our families, our communities, and our world.


At the August 26, 2025 Session meeting, your Session took the following actions:

- Approved adding Chris Hurley (our new Treasurer) and Wendy Fields (our corporation president) as signers for all financial institutions. This means they can sign checks. The Session approved removing Kathi Ramirez as a signer.
- Approved a motion from your Nominating Ministry Team to amend the Church's bylaws extending the length of term for Deacon, Elder and Trustees from two year to threeyear terms
- Please note that more information is forth coming and this will be fully explained before it is brought before the congregation for a vote at our October 26th congregational meeting. A change in the bylaws requires a three-quarters majority approval.
- Approved a motion from your Spiritual Growth Ministry Team approving Rainforest Falls for the 2026 Vacation Bible School curriculum.
- Approved a motion from your Spiritual Growth Ministry Team approving a list of curriculum for the Thursday morning Bible Study which will be co-led by Sharon Morgan and Donna Herman.
- Approved the 2025 Covenant Commitment form which will be sent to our Presbytery office.

after worship for about 10-15 people. If you are willing to help, please sign up on the sign-up page in the entry way or let Pastor Mark know.






