WHAT HAPPENS AT THE PACK? Your Pack Patrol will provide a brief training session, then you will work in assembly lines to package our highly nutritious meals. Please wear closed-toed shoes and be prepared to rock a hairnet. After a short cleanup time, we will take a group photo for Facebook promotion of our mission and your volunteerism. Thursday Evening Men's and Women's groups for 20s and 30s

Our Thursday night small groups are designed to connect individuals in a similar stage of life, whether you're single, married, with or without kids. We meet at the church weekly at 6:30 PM and rotate between Bible study and caring for the children. One week, the women gather for study while the men supervise the kids; the next week, we switch. It's a practical way to support one another, grow in faith, and help meet the common need for childcare while building community.

We are currently working through the book of Galatians and so bring your Bible on study nights!



Are you looking to get involved at HUMC? Have you thought of joining a committee? If so, we have several committees that would love to have your input:

Finance Committee members review financial statements monthly and meet quarterly to discuss recommendations for the leadership committee. Knowledge of financial statements and QuickBooks is helpful but not mandatory.

<u>Trustees Committee</u> members are responsible for the oversight of all property matters. This includes building maintenance, remodeling and improvements.

<u>SPP Committee</u> members assist the pastor and staff in various ways as they carry out their leadership responsibilities. Hospitality Committee members recommend activities and systems to respond to the evangelistic mission of the church. This includes implementing ministries which care for members, persons new to the church and inactive members.

Missions Committee members are responsible for providing missional opportunities and initiatives for the church to participate in throughout the year.
