

WEEK 4
WHEN WE PRAY... GOD'S WILL SHOWS THE WAY

God's will isn't as much about a "map" as it is about a "compass"—guiding us to honor God wherever we are.

Philippians 1:9-10

⁹ And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, ¹⁰ so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be blameless until the day of Christ...

The key to knowing God's will is knowing God.

1 Samuel 23:1-2

¹ When David was told, "Look, the Philistines are fighting against Keilah and are looting the threshing floors," ² he inquired of the Lord, saying, "Shall I go and attack these Philistines?" The Lord answered him, "Go, attack the Philistines and save Keilah."

1 Samuel 30:7-8

⁷ Then David said to Abiathar the priest, the son of Ahimelech, "Bring me the ephod." Abiathar brought it to him, ⁸ and David inquired of the Lord, "Shall I pursue this raiding party? Will I overtake them" "Pursue them," he answered. "You will certainly overtake them and succeed in the rescue."

Seeking God's will requires patience.

1 Samuel 13:8-14

⁸ He waited seven days, the time set by Samuel; but Samuel did not come to Gilgal, and Saul's men began to scatter. ⁹ So he said, "Bring me the burnt offerings." And Saul offered up the burnt offering. ¹⁰ Just as he finished making the offering, Samuel arrived, and Saul went out to greet him. ¹¹ "What have you done?" asked Samuel. Saul replied, "When I saw that the men were scattering, and that you did not come at the set time, and that the Philistines were assembling at Micmash, ¹² I thought, 'Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and I have not sought the Lord's favor.' So I felt compelled to offer the burnt offering." ¹³ "You acted foolishly," Samuel said. "You have not kept the command the Lord your God gave you; if you had, he would have established your kingdom over Israel for all time. ¹⁴ But now your kingdom will not endure; the Lord has sought out a man after his own heart and appointed him leader of his people, because you have not kept the Lord's command."

1 Samuel 28:5-7

⁵ When Saul saw the Philistine army, he was afraid; terror filled his heart. ⁶ He inquired of the Lord, but the Lord did not answer him by dreams or Urim or Prophets. ⁷ Saul then said to his attendants, "Find me a woman who is a medium, so I may go and inquire of her."

True faith seeks God's will before the decision is made, not after.

How do we pray for God's will?

Pray for love to overflow in wisdom and discernment.
Pray with open hands, surrendering your own agenda.
Pray scripture so that your heart learns God's desires.
Psalm 143:8,10 Be Let the morning bring me word of your unfailing love, for I have put my trust in you. Show me the way I should go, for to you I lift up my soul. Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good Spirit lead me on level ground.

Pray with patience, trusting God's timing.

Stop asking God to bless your will, and start asking Him to bend your will to His.
