## *A word from Pastor Justin*

Mt. Pisgah family,

This past weekend we celebrated Rally Sunday, a cherished tradition among many Protestant congregations that marks the beginning of our full program year. What a joy it was to worship together with the leadership of our new contemporary band, share a delicious breakfast between services, and hear about the many ministries thriving in our community of faith.

Over the summer, our leadership teams worked diligently in preparation for the year ahead, and it is inspiring to see how the Holy Spirit has been guiding our congregation. We are delighted to welcome four new staff members: Adam Ormond as Organist and Handbell Director, Connor Stillwell as Audio/Visual Technician, and Brandon and Kelly Deal as Co-Contemporary Worship Leaders. Each of them brings unique gifts and a deep commitment to enhancing our worship life and helping all who gather here feel more deeply connected to God. In addition, we are launching new weekly Bible studies, a revitalized confirmation program, and a new handbell ministry.

Beyond our congregation, the wider Evangelical Lutheran Church in America is also experiencing exciting transitions. 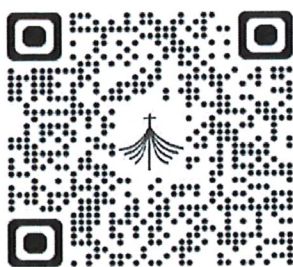

## Treasury Report from July/August 2025

8/25/25



Our fiscal year closed on June 30, 2025. We had annual income of \$425,885, which is 12% below budget. Full year expenses were \$410,976, which is 15% below budget. So, despite income being below budget, we spent \$14,909 less than we received. We also ended the year with \$115,388 in our reserve fund which is an increase of \$28,936 over year-end for last year.

The budget for the 2025-2026 fiscal year that was approved in May is \$456,226, which is 7% above where we finished the year in June. We had income of \$61,533 in July, which is 62% over budget. Expenses were \$43,420 in July, which is 14% over budget. We spent \$18,113 less than we received. Our congregation is in good shape financially, but we will need everyone's generosity in order to meet our budget.

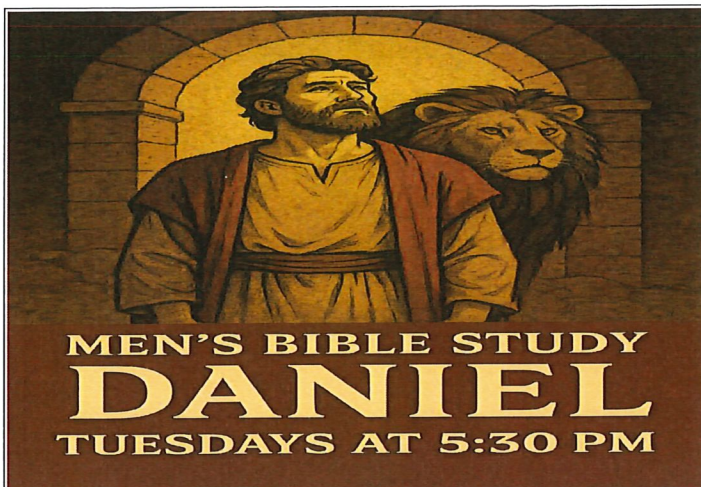
I am just beginning my time as Treasurer, so I hope that I can live up to the standards set by Rod Poole.

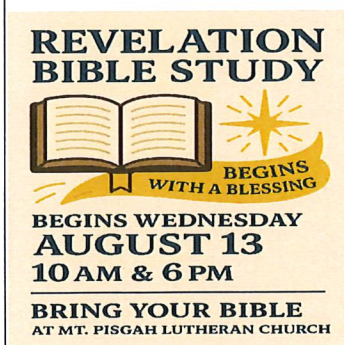


### Men's Bible Study: The Book of Daniel

Join us as we learn from Daniel's example of courage and discover how to live faithfully in today's world.



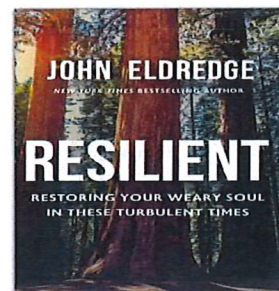

All are welcome—whether you're familiar with The Chosen or brand new to it. Come ready to watch, read, and share!



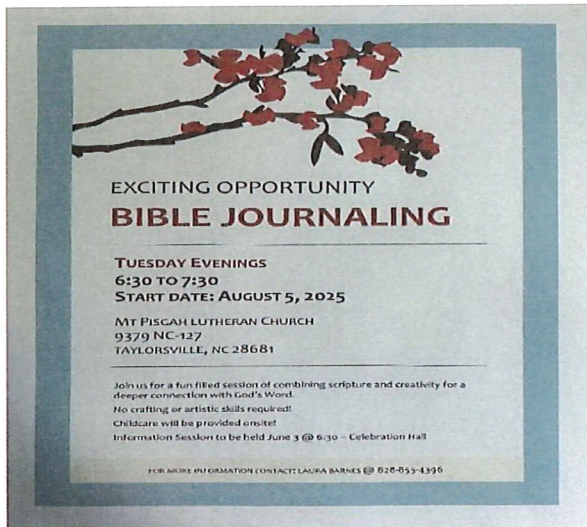

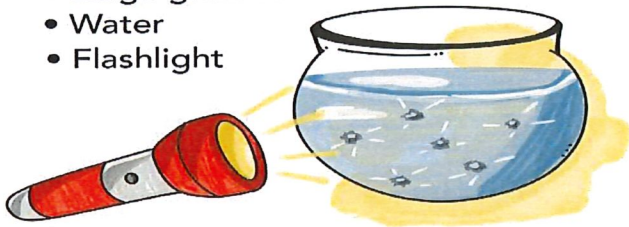
## Fun Family Activity



Why do stars appear to twinkle? Try this experiment to find out!

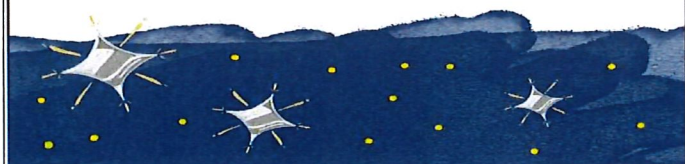
### What you need:

- Aluminum foil
- Large glass bowl
- Water
- Flashlight



### What you do:

1. Crumple the foil into a ball. Carefully unfold it and lay it flat on the ground.
2. Fill the bowl with water and place it on the foil.
3. Turn off the lights and make the room as dark as possible. Shine the flashlight about 1 foot from the water's undisturbed surface. Light will reflect onto the foil.
4. Then tap your finger on the water's surface. As the water moves, what happens to the light on the foil?
5. This flickering simulates scintillation, which happens when starlight enters Earth's atmosphere. As light passes through layers of gas and water, it refracts and appears to twinkle.



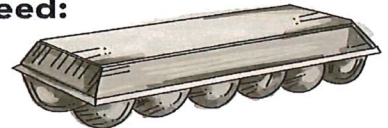
## Fun Family Activity



Geodes look plain on the outside but contain beautiful crystals. Create these "rocks" to show how God makes us new on the inside.

### What you need:

- Clean cardboard egg carton
- Scissors (and adult help)
- Epsom salt
- Plastic zippered bags (one per color of dye)
- Food coloring
- Glue
- Paintbrush



### What you do:

1. Cut out the tops and bottoms of all the egg compartments so you can make 6 ball shapes.
2. In each bag, put 3 tablespoons of Epsom salt and a drop or two of food coloring. Seal and shake to mix.
3. With the paintbrush, spread glue inside two egg-carton halves. Sprinkle a spoonful of Epsom salt into those halves. Then close and shake.
4. Open your homemade geode and shake out excess salt.
5. Optional: Preserve the crystals with a coat of clear-drying glue.

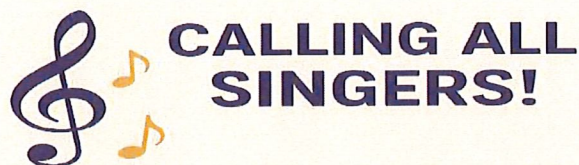

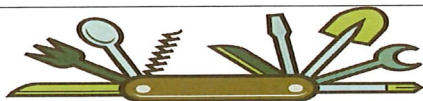

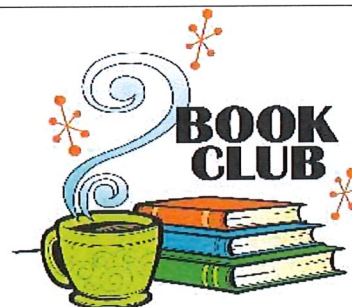
