As you know if you've been following us for the last few years, July is Dan's busiest time of the year. First, he is finishing up the review and approval of almost 100 budgets for all his Global Workers. At the same time, he begins a 3-month-long audit season. And finally, two weeks in the middle of July are what is called Summer Summit. Summer Summit is multiple major events all at once. The biggest is "Home Assignment Debrief," a week-long conference for all WorldVenture Global Workers who are in the US for home assignment. It includes debriefing their previous term, training, and getting reacquainted with mission personnel. An age-appropriate parallel program is offered for their children. At the same time, there is "Launch," an 8-day program of final training for those appointees who are almost ready to deploy to their field of service for the first time. And finally, there is "Emeritus," a 4-day program for those workers who are within a few years of retirement, to assist them in preparing for that transition. If this sounds overwhelming, it is!

It's an exhausting time, but also an exhilarating time. Dan loves the one-on-one appointments in which he can answer all a worker's questions and help them with any financial challenges they are facing. Another highlight is that each Global Worker gives a 15-minute ministry report. Hearing what God is doing around the world through these faithful servants is always exciting, but they also share the challenges they have faced or are facing, many of which are heartrending. So it is encouraging to everyone when we get to pray for them individually after each report.


