


Hebrews 8

⁵ They (human high priests) serve at a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven. This is why Moses was warned when he was about to build the tabernacle: "See to it that you make everything according to the pattern shown you on the mountain."

Hebrews 9


Now the first covenant had regulations for worship and also an earthly sanctuary. ² **A tabernacle was set up**. In its <u>first room</u> were the lampstand and the table with its consecrated bread; this was called the Holy Place. ³ Behind the second curtain was <u>a room called the Most Holy Place</u>, ⁴ which had the golden altar of incense and the gold-covered ark of the covenant. This ark contained the gold jar of manna, Aaron's staff that had budded, and the stone tablets of the covenant. ⁵ Above the ark were the cherubim of the Glory, overshadowing the atonement cover ("the mercy seat").

The Tabernacle is a pattern for worship




Altar of Sacrifice

- The cross of Jesus is our altar




Bronze Basin

Exodus 40:22–23
He put the table in the Tent of Meeting, on the north side of the tabernacle, outside the veil. And he set the bread in order upon it before the Lord.



Exodus 40:24-25 He put the lampstand in the tent of meeting opposite the table, on the south side of the tabernacle. And he set up the lamps before the Lord, as the Lord had commanded Moses.




Psalm 104:4

But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

Exodus 30:6 You shall put it (altar of incense) in front of the veil that is above the ark of the testimony, in front of the mercy seat that is over the testimony, where I will meet with you.

Revelation 8:3–5

Another angel came and stood at the altar with a golden censer, and he was given much incense to offer with the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, rose before God from the hand of the angel. Then the angel took the censer and filled it with fire from the altar and threw it on the earth, and there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake.

Psalm 100:4
Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.

Exodus 26:33-34 You shall bring in the ark of the testimony there within the veil... and the veil shall separate for you the Holy Place from the Most Holy. You shall put the mercy seat on the ark of the testimony in the Most Holy Place.
