"When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. 2 And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. 3 Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit" — Acts 2:1-4, NRSVUE

Each time I write Spark Notes, my prayer is that it ignites something within you—a deeper thought, a renewed commitment, a fresh hunger for God. 
Scripture reveals God's living Word and anchors us in the Pentecost promise that "your sons and

daughters will prophesy...your young will see visions, and your elders will dream dreams."

**Tradition** reminds us that we stand on the shoulders of faithful believers who carried the flame before us.

**Reason** invites us to love God with our minds, asking how best to live out faith in a complex world.

**Experience** is where God meets us personally—just as He did with John Wesley on that unforgettable night at



Aldersgate. It was there Wesley felt his heart "strangely warmed," and came to fully grasp the depth of God's grace for him. That spark of assurance changed the course of his life—and through him, the lives of millions.

This theological task doesn't just shape what we believe—it shapes how we live. It challenges us to be thoughtful, Spirit-led, and courageous in our witness. It calls us to be a spark of the Social Gospel in our community, not for show, but for the sake of love, justice, and transformation.

As we live into this Pentecost season, I invite you to reflect: Where is the Spirit sparking something new in you? How might you ignite faith in someone else?
