In 1905, a farmer in North Carolina recorded the date of his first corn planting. He did the same every year until his death in 1950. We will talk about how our "hustle" culture can deceive us by promoting the idea that being busy equates to being successful and important.


These three days will fill your heart and reset your soul as you enjoy a weekend of rest, reflection. fellowship, and encouragement through uplifting teaching and worship music.




