Going Deeper Together

Text: Romans 6:1-14

Key Ideas from the Sermon: Paul compares and contrasts the first and last Adams (Adam and Jesus Christ). These are the two Representative Heads of all humanity.

- As we identify with Christ in his death, our old nature dies and we are dead to sin.
- We are now not so much "sinners saved by grace" as if we still live in sin, no, we are "saints who at times sin", even struggle with sin, but we are saints nonetheless.
- Living and growing in the love and grace of God in Christ has the effect over time of displacing sin in our lives.

Bible Study: The Swedish Method [Rom 6:1-14]

- 1. Begin by praying, asking God to speak through His Word
- 2. Read the Bible passage aloud, being careful to read slowly
- 3. Go back over the passage (allow about 10 minutes of silence), being on the lookout for, and making notes on the following four things:

Light bulb: This should be something that 'shine 'from the passage - whatever impacts most, or draws attention.
