We go out into the world, we confront the lies, we confront the anti-God, anti-Christ speculations, theories, ideologies, systems, and we smash them to the ground.

The history of Paul's conversion takes place in Acts 9; the internal working is described in Philippians 3.

He had an anti-Christ posture and position.

The most devastating issue to deal with in ministry is the issue of spiritual defection.

Judas provides a sort of strange encouragement to us because even under the Lord of Lords' tutelage and discipleship, there was a defector.
