All things in love...(13-14)

A community expressing its faith in love...

Intentionally Refreshing (15-18)

A community devoted to refreshing others and itself through the patterns of servant leadership, giving recognition to those who are shining examples.

Actively Greeting (19-20)

A community giving and receiving greetings, encouraging, and practicing small yet dynamic ways to hold together.

Participating as one body in Christ (21-24)

A community held together by Jesus our Lord, loving him, eagerly awaiting his return while recognizing and sharing his grace with one another.

How might we live as disciples of Jesus and function together as his church in an overwhelmingly not-yet believing world?

In love we desire to do all things, encouraging and building one another up for the glory of God, holding onto the person and work of Jesus, our greatest source of unity and strength. Participating together, as the church in Christ, we are motivated and compelled to love, live, and serve according to the example of his life.
