- **1.** Reserve your own printed 40-day prayer journal. Made here at CMBC by our staff, this journal will serve as a hard copy, walking you through each of the 40 days of prayer. Sign up on the <u>communication form</u> or contact the church office (<u>cmbc@calvarymonument.org</u>).
- 2. Sign up to be part of our 40 Days of Prayer email group. Each day, members of this group will receive an email in the morning with their prayer content found in the email. Sign up on the <u>communication form</u> or contact the church office (<u>cmbc@calvarymonument.org</u>).
- 3. Receive daily prayer content through our CMBC app. You can find the CMBC app, and download it for free, in the App Store (iPhone users), or Google Play store (Android users). Make sure you opt in for notifications! This content will be available on the app even if you prefer not to get notifications just open your app on March 7!

Finally, we desire for this 40 Days of Prayer to supplement, not overtake, your current daily prayer habits and practices. Please continue to make use of your monthly prayer calendar (to pray for our congregation, ministries, and global partners) and weekly Intercessor (to pray for more pressing and time sensitive needs within our body) alongside of, and together with, your 40 day prayer journal. Both of these documents can be found in our foyer and are regularly available to our CMBC family.

# **YOUTHFUL REFLECTIONS**

Times change and often so does life. A year ago at this time we were just learning about Covid-19. We had no idea that it would affect the world in the way it did this past year. I remember being surprised when we started to talk about conducting services from home and needed to come up with a plan for ministry online. How many times did we find ourselves acclimating to the unexpected?

Jesus told His disciples, as recorded in Luke 8:22-23, that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised. He then proceeded to inform them that, if anyone would follow Him, he should deny himself and take up his cross *daily* and follow Him. How do you imagine they received these words? How do you picture the look on their faces? Surprised? Confused?

Life certainly changed for them when they were embraced as disciples of Jesus. Life changed even more when they discovered what Jesus meant by these instructions.

Do you tend to be afraid of change? Do you run from it? What if the change is for your good? What if the change is really difficult (like denying yourself), yet leads to an even closer, deeper walk with Jesus? What if the change involves you letting something go that you have held onto for far too long and instead trust the Lord with it? Ask the Lord to help you to trust and obey. There is no other way to be happy in Jesus than to trust and obey in whatever change God may bring.
