Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b>Read the Text</b> -read the text together. (Matthew 28:16-20)</p> <p><b>Discussion Guiding Questions:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Discuss the contrasts between the commission that was given to the guards in Matthew 28:11-15 and the commission that Jesus gives his disciples in verses 16-20.</li> <li>2. Why does Jesus choose to call, equip, and use weak and imperfect people like us? What does this demonstrate regarding the goodness of God, the love of God, and the power of God?</li> <li>3. How does the great commission that Jesus leaves with his disciples compare or correspond to the charge that God gives Adam &amp; Eve, and Noah in Genesis 1:28 and Genesis 9:1?</li> <li>4. What are the core components of the Great Commission? What exactly is it that Jesus is asking his disciples to do?</li> <li>5. What promise does Jesus leave us with that should be incredibly hopeful as we seek to fulfill the Great Commission today?
