40 DAYS *of* PRAYER

Our elders, pastors, and staff are calling the CMBC family to unite through prayer. Starting on Sunday, March 7, we will pray for 40 days on topics and themes surrounding truths related to God our Father, Christ our Savior, and the Holy Spirit our Helper. We will pray together, asking the Holy Spirit to motivate within us a desire to demonstrate attitudes and behaviors that are honoring to God. All of our Pastors and Staff have contributed in pulling together the topics and themes for the 40 days before us. We are praying that these 40 days will be a special time of Jesus at work within our congregation, growing us in a greater love for Him and each other.

There will be three options for you to receive daily prayer content. Please feel free to sign up for more than one way to receive your daily prayer content.

- 1. Reserve your own printed 40-day prayer journal.** Made here at CMBC by our staff, this journal will serve as a hard copy, walking you through each of the 40 days of prayer. *Sign up on the [communication form](#) or contact the church office (cmbc@calvarymonument.org).*
- 2. Sign up to be part of our 40 Days of Prayer email group.** Each day, members of this group will receive an email in the morning with their prayer content found in the email. *Sign up on the [communication form](#) or contact the church office (cmbc@calvarymonument.org).*
- 3. Receive daily prayer content through our CMBC app.** You can find the CMBC app, and download it for free, in the App Store (iPhone users), or Google Play store (Android users). Make sure you opt in for notifications! *This content will be available on the app even if you prefer not to get notifications - just open your app on March 7!*

Finally, we desire for this 40 Days of Prayer to supplement, not overtake, your current daily prayer habits and practices. Please continue to make use of your monthly prayer calendar (to pray for our congregation, ministries, and global partners) and weekly Intercessor (to pray for more pressing and time sensitive needs within our body) alongside of, and together with, your 40 day prayer journal. Both of these documents can be found in our foyer and are regularly available to our CMBC family.

Thank you for praying together with us. We look forward to beginning our 40 days of corporate prayer starting on Sunday, March 7!

<p>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</p> <p>Start with Prayer -ask Jesus to guide your time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> -read the text together. (1 Cor. 13:8-13)</p> <p><u>Discussion Guiding Questions:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Love is the preeminent gift that has been given to the people of God. Talk about how love is set apart from some of the more minor gifts of prophesy, tongues, knowledge. Why do you think the people of God in Corinth desired the more minor gifts, over love? 2. Read Genesis 11:1-9 together. Make of note of what man said, and what God said. What was man's sin (vs 4)? How was the gift of tongues or languages evidence that was once again restoring that which had been confused? 3. Why will gifts like tongues, prophesy and knowledge no longer be necessary for the Church when Christ returns, and we are ushered into our eternal state? 4. Why is it important for us to keep verse 12 in front of us as a Church? How can Paul's instruction that we only, "know in part" help to keep us humble and open to listening from other perspectives? 5. Read 1 John 4:7-20 together. Make observations related to the word love and share with each other, what this passage is teaching us about God, and about love. <p><u>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text challenge you to grow in a greater love for God? 2. How are you motivated to grow in a greater love for others? 3. How might Jesus be motivating you apply some of the principles from this passage to your family, career, community, or church? 4. How might Jesus be using you to draw those that do not know him, unto himself? 5.
